






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








triangle and cut off the very tip of the point. this will be where we poke a hole for the pole. Repeat on second piece.







umbrella and the cutouts help it





Roll a third piece of paper to make a pole, or use a pencil. Poke through both pieces to make the umbrella stick.









## Note

The actual "Personal Space Dress" uses a very similar technique, with modified umbrella parts. The main difference is: motors installed under the skirt, between the top and bottom piece, control the movement of the lower piece, and allow it to be automated.
